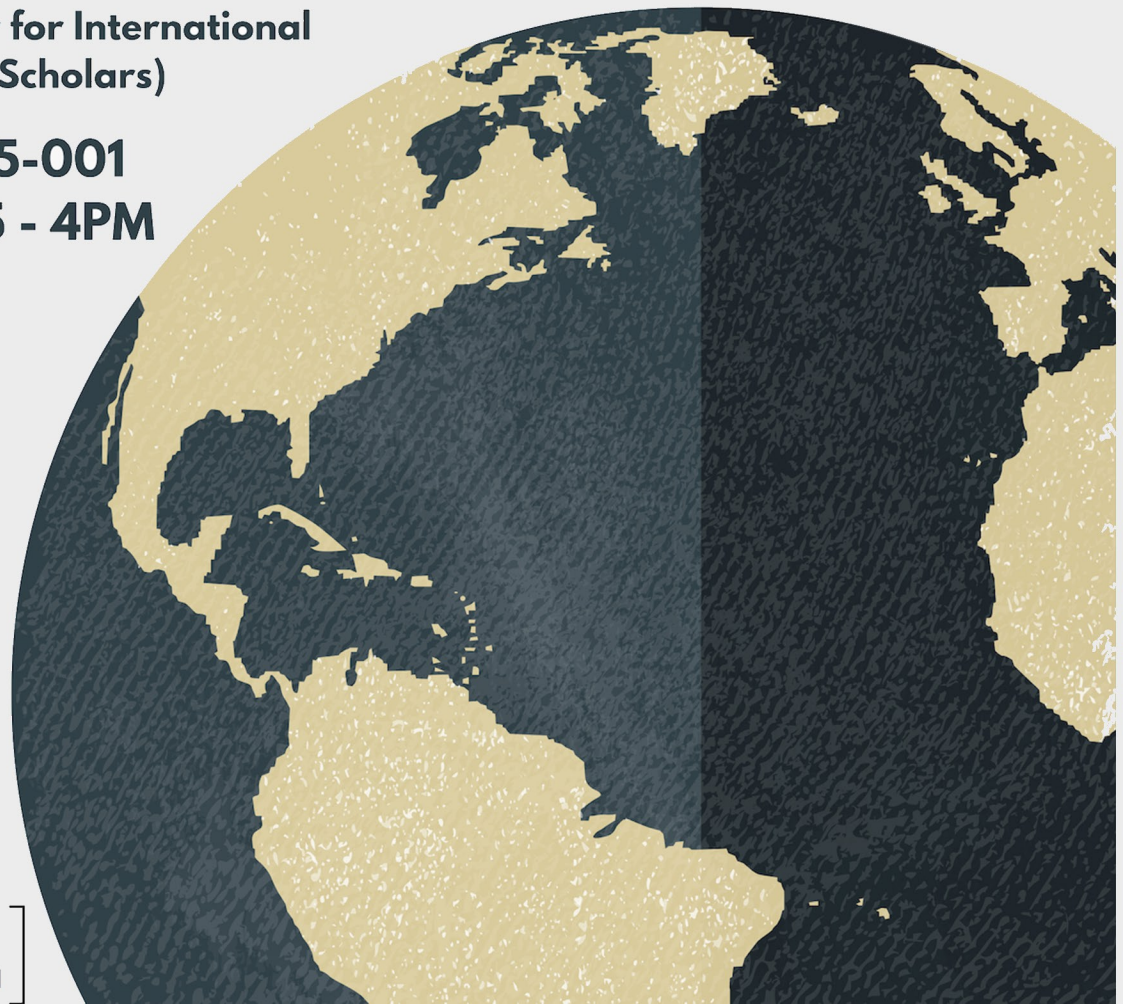
CROSSING BORDERS
